School Mission Statement

Course Description

This course is the basic health course required of all pupils. Topics to be covered will include, but are not limited to, physical health, fitness, nutrition, mental and emotional health, etc.

- Accommodations for students with special needs will be strictly followed in accordance with the special education department's recommendations as well as the information in the student's IEP per board policy. If there is another special need that a student may need accommodations for (i.e. diabetes, asthma, etc.), we ask that the parent/guardian, doctor, or student make the instructor aware of these immediately.
- Methods of instruction will include but not be limited to: google classroom, lecture, class discussion, google slides presentations, hands-on activities, group work, and guest speakers.

I. Grading Policy

- Class grade will be determined with a total points system. The number of points earned by the student and the total number of possible points earned will be averaged to calculate a final grade.
- Points will be earned through unit tests, quizzes, projects, in-class assignments, notes, being prepared for class, daily bell ringers and exit slips.
- If absent from class, students must check google classroom for assignments and get the make up work out of the tray if needed. <u>You will be given the number of days absent, plus one day, to turn in</u> <u>make-up work for full credit.</u>

II. In Person Class Procedures

- Students are to be seated after they enter the classroom.
- Students will begin working on their daily bell ringer activity after they are seated.
- During class lessons, students will be required to comment and follow along with powerpoints uploaded into the classroom.
- All textbooks are to be returned to the cart at the end of the period. YOU WILL NOT BE ASSIGNED YOUR OWN TEXTBOOK. (this is why taking notes during class is of great importance). You will have a copy of the class text on your google classroom under the ABOUT Tab.
- No one is allowed to leave class the first 10 minutes and last 10 minutes of the period.

III. Online Class Expectations

- Students are expected to log-into google classroom everyby the start of class.
- Cameras are to be on until I let you know that cameras need to be turned off.
- Students are to be dressed appropriately for class with lights on and sitting up for our lessons.
- Assignments will be posted no later than 8 am and will have a due date posted on the assignment.
- Students are expected to have their notifications turned ON in google classroom so they get emails when an assignment is posted, announcement is made, etc.
- All class work is due by the dates listed which is normally the same day by 8:59 pm.
